

INSTRUCTIONS

Making Pattern for Mirror Face

These instructions are for making paper patterns for MultiVex mirror faces from OEM mirror faces. These are thumbnail imprint patterns, without any pencil or ink lines. Plain white paper (cc paper) works well. **Always make separate Left Hand and Right Hand patterns**, even though the OEM mirrors appear to be symmetrical and of the same size and shape, there are often subtle differences.

- 1) Approximate paper size for various vehicle applications, as follows:

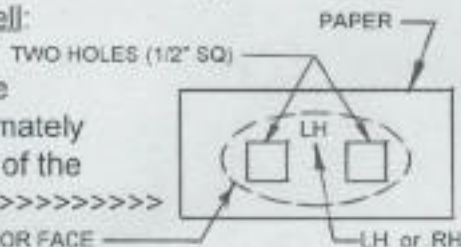
Motorcycles & Passenger cars = 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"

Light trucks & SUV's = 8 1/2" x 11"

LARGER MIRRORS REQUIRE
LARGER PAPER SIZE
(DO NOT COMPROMISE)

- 2) For accuracy, when making a thumb line imprint of the exact OEM mirror glass face, it is necessary to prevent the paper from shifting on the mirror face. To do this, the following procedure works well:

Using a sharp pocket knife, or single edge razor blade, or whatever, cut two approximately 1/2" square holes in the horizontal center of the paper about 2" to 3" apart (SEE SKETCH) >>>>>>>>>



- 3) Apply 3/4" wide magic tape over the 1/2" sq. holes on one side of paper.
- 4) Center and attach paper over the OEM mirror face with sticky side of tape.
- 5) Using thumb nails and/or fingernails, trace the exact outline of the OEM mirror face glass portion, leaving a **well defined scored impression** all around the mirror face. **Do not pencil or ink the scored impressions on the paper.**
- 6) Carefully remove the paper pattern from the OEM mirror face.
- 7) Apply another 3/4" strip of magic tape over the square holes on the back side of the paper pattern, thus covering the originally exposed sticky surfaces.
- 8) Using ball point pen, mark the front face of the pattern showing:
TOP of pattern, marked LH or RH; and vehicle: **YEAR, MAKE, MODEL**, and the **DATE**.
- 9) If the OEM mirror glass is set into a plastic BEZEL, **make note of it on the pattern**, and the **depth** that the mirror face is below the outer lip of the BEZEL.
EXAMPLE: 1/8" BEZEL, or FLUSH if no BEZEL !
